Profitable sustainable plantation forests

Environmental, social and economic integrity are core values of Forestry Plantations Queensland Pty Ltd (FPQ). FPQ is committed to sustainable plantation forest management. FPQ will:

(a) Conduct operations:

- in accordance with all legal and other requirements; and
- demonstrate due diligence to prevent environmental harm.

(b) Achieve sound and balanced environmental outcomes by:

- collaborating in the development of policies and standards;
- meeting all sustainable forest management requirements covering environmental, economic and social aspects as prescribed;
- regular independent review; and
- assessing its activities in the context of long term sustainability and the need to deliver the best balance between the various economic, social and environmental aspects of its management activities.

(c) Allocate sufficient resources to sustain the production systems over time, based on sound scientific principles, applied research and community standards.

(d) Strive continually to improve operations to enhance production and prevent loss, waste and pollution.

(e) Ensure operations are carried out in a safe and healthy manner by competent staff and contractors.

(f) Consult with, and consider the views of our stakeholders and interested parties, and openly communicate environmental management activities and outcomes both internally and externally.

(g) Gain public recognition as a socially and environmentally responsible commercial forest plantation manager including compliance with the Australian Forestry Standard and Forest Stewardship Council Principles and Criteria.

(h) Assess our performance against baseline environmental performance data.

(i) Review our management procedures so as to maintain a contemporary approach to sustainable forest management.
